

Merchant MCC Check

Reduce risk and increase revenue by correcting Merchant Category Code (MCC) misclassification.

MCCs are used to classify a merchant type by the goods or services they provide. An example of a classification could be a hotel, office supply store, casino, etc. As the list of high-risk merchant types increases, portfolio transparency becomes increasingly important.

Merchant MCC Check is an analyst-reviewed business classifier that identifies mismatches and incorrectly coded merchants. This process helps you avoid insufficient reserves, excessive commissions, and missed upsell opportunities. You can identify which merchants have changes in business activities that could represent higher risk categories, avoid prohibited categories and improve reserve and chargeback positions.

We scan portfolios for both online and offline customers and validates the MCC and description for each business customer. We highlight business customers that correspond with a high-risk MCC list, which can be customized based on the needs of your organization.
