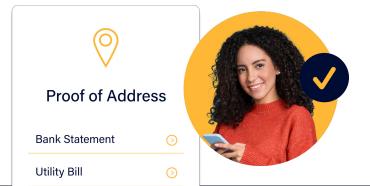

How POA verification works

1 Upload

Begin the proof of address (POA) verification process with a single click and upload a PDF or image file.

2 Document scanning

Verify the type and issue date of the POA document. Easily verify acceptable documents such as bank statements and utility bills.

3 Data extraction

Automatically extract and validate address details from documents.

verification

Real-time address Ensure that a user's address matches official POA documents such as utility bills or bank statements.



POA document upload

Support various proof of address documents, including utility bills, bank statements, and government-issued documents for verification.



OCR for data extraction

Use optical character recognition (OCR) in 164 languages to extract address data from documents.



Al-driven data categorization Automatically categorize extracted address data to streamline verification with routing and reduce manual intervention.



Fuzzy matching for validation

Compares extracted name and address details with pre-existing user information to detect discrepancies and ensure accuracy.



Issue date identification Identifies the issuance date of POA documents to confirm their validity and ensure compliance with recency requirements.
